Kirkby Stephen Vintage Transport Day & Dentdale and Sedbergh. B Walk Strenuous 15 miles. Alight and Return Horton

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 10 miles. Alight and Return Dent

The Howgills: Sedbergh, Arant Haw, Calder, Bram Rigg Top, Swarth Greaves, Sedbergh. Bus to/from Sedbergh.

D Walk Moderate 9 miles. Alight Kirkby Stephen, Return Appleby

Brough, Lowgill Farm, Warcop, Sandford Bridge, Little Ormside, Great Ormside, River Eden.

Vintage Bus to Brough.

E Walk Easy 7 miles. Alight and Return Dent

The Falls of Rawthey: New Bridge, Garsdale Bridge, Dovecote Gill, Fellgate, Hall Gill, River Rawthey. Bus to/from Sedbergh.

F Walk Easy 5 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen

Enjoy Vintage Transport Day: Walk the Viaduct Trail. Optional tour around Kirkby Stephen.

Wensleydale – Leyburn and Middleham

B Walk Strenuous 13 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Addleborough: Worton, Addleborough, Great Silk Top, Stalling Busk, Marsett Hawes. Coach to Worton from Hawes.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 13 miles. Alight Garsdale, Return Kirkby Stephen.

Lady Anne Clifford's Walk: Hell Gill Bridge, Pendragon Castle, Lammerside Castle, Wharton Hall.

D Walk Moderate 8 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Middleham, Stepping Stones, East Witton, Jervaulx Abbey, River Ure, Middleham.

Coach to/from Middleham.

E Walk Easy 7 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Wensley, Bolton Hall, Middleham Low Moor, The Rides, Middleham.

Coach to Wensley/from Middleham.

F Walk Easy 5 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Visit Jervaulx Abbey (optional refreshments): River Ure, Cover Bridge, Middleham Castle, time to look around Middleham. Coach to Jervaulx/from Middleham.

Sunday 18th April

B Walk Strenuous 14 miles. Alight Kirkby Stephen, Return Garsdale.

Wild Boar Fell: Ash Fell, Stennerskeugh Fell End, Wild Boar Fell, Swarth Fell.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 12 miles. Alight and Return Settle.

Limestone Scars and Caves: Attermire Cave, Fair Sleets Gate, Ing Scar Crag, Langscar Gate, Jubilee Cave.

D Walk Moderate 9 miles. Alight and Return Appleby.

Brandley Bridge, Hoff, Rutter Falls, Great Ormside, Westmorland Way.

E Walk Moderately Easy 8 miles. Alight and Return Horton.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 13 miles. Alight Horton, Return Settle.

Pen-y-Ghent: Horton Scar, Hull Pot, Foxup Moor, Pen-y-Ghent, Moor Head Lane, Ribble Way, Stainforth.

D Walk Moderate 9 miles. Alight Lazonby, Return Langwathby.

History in the Landscape: Kirkoswald Church, Clocher Castle, "Romany's Memorial", Park End, Addingham Church, Long Meg and Her Daughters, Little Salkeld Mill.

E Walk Easy 8 miles. Alight and Return Appleby.

Hungriggs, Flakebridge House, Shepherds Cottage, Murton, Hilton, Brackenber, Langton, Stank Wood.

G Walk Easy Stroll 1½ miles (in 2 parts). Alight and Return Carlisle.

Carlisle City Walk: a quick look at Carlisle Citadel and into the city up to the Priory Church.

Break for Lunch. Then to St. Cuthbert's Churchyard to hear of the notorious body-snatchers, "the resurrection men". On to the Market Square and the Old Town Hall to hear how the citizens were controlled by the social and sanitary regulations contained in the Dormant or "Sleeping Book" and how special regulations kept dogs, pigs and Scotsmen under control.
