

Sunday 5th September

Dentdale and Sedbergh

B walk Strenuous 15 miles. Alight and Return Horton.

Pen-y-Ghent: Brackenbottom, Dalehead, Hesleden Bergh, Foxup Moor, Plover Hill, Pen-y-Ghent, Hull Pot.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 12 miles. Alight and Return Dent.

Dales Way: The classic walk through Dentdale from Cowgill, through Dent Town, to Brackensgill to Sedbergh. Bus from Sedbergh.

D Walk Moderate 9 miles. Alight and Return Dent.

In Fox's Footsteps: Sedbergh, High Branthwaite, Hole House, Fox's Pulpit, Lincoln Bridge Inn, Briggflatts Meeting House, Sedbergh. Bus to/from Sedbergh.

E Walk Moderately Easy 7 miles. Alight and Return Settle.

History in the Landscape: 120,000 years in Ribblesdale. From prehistoric caves – Attermire, Victoria and Jubilee, to the early extractive industries and textiles, to Langcliffe and Stainforth. Join our walk and see for yourself.

F Walk Easy 6 miles. Alight and Return Dent.

Dent Town, Dales Way, Barth Bridge, Dillicar, Eilers, Brackensgill, Gate Manor, Millthrop, Sedbergh.

Bus to Dent Town from Sedbergh.

Heritage Weekend in Wensleydale

A Walk Strenuous 13 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Wes Witton, Middleham High Moor, St Simon's Bridge, Red Way, Slip Wath, Slipstone Crags, East Witton, Middleham. Coach to West Witton, from Middleham.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 10 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

West Witton, Capple Bank, Henhouse Hill, Melmerby, Carlton, Cote Bridge, West Burton, Aysgarth. Coach to West Witton, from Aysgarth.

E Walk Easy 6 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

West Witton, Top Barn, Spigot Lodge, Ashgill, Coverham, Coverham Lane, Middleham, Time to explore Middleham. Coach to West Witton, from Middleham.

F Walk Easy 4 miles. Alight and Return Ribbleshead.

Heritage Weekend and the local history society are here to tell you about Middleham.

We have a short walk in the countryside around, then we shall explore the historic town with its castle – home of the last English King – Richard III. Coach to/from Middleham.

Other Walks

D Walk Moderate 8 miles. Alight and Return Horton.

Climb a Peak Slowly: Ingleborough, the classic ascent of Yorkshire's favourite peak, on a walk full of fascinating facts. Sulber Nick, Simon Fell Breast, Ingleborough summit, Descending to Crina Bottom and Fell Lane into Ingleton. Bus to Settle (fare extra, concessions free).

Sunday 19th September

B Walk Strenuous 14 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen.

Waitby, Smardale Mill, Crosby Garrett, Potts valley, Ewefell Mire, Smardale Bridge, Smardale Fell, Kirkby Stephen.

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 13 miles. Alight Garsdale, Return Kirkby Stephen.

Lady Anne Clifford's Walk: Hellgill Bridge, Pendragon Castle, Lammerside Castle, Wharton Hall, Kirkby Stephen.

D Walk Moderate 9 miles. Alight and Return Langwathby.

Old racecourse, Winskill, Long Meg and her Daughters, Addingham Old Church, Park End, Romany's memorial, Kirkoswald – castle, church and town, Eden Gorge, Lacy Caves, Little Salkeld Mill.

F Walk Easy 7 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen.

History in the Landscape: Lord Wharton's Deer Park. Wharton Dykes, Bull Gill, Lammerside Castle, Mire Close Bridge, Wharton Hall, Whinny Hill.

Sunday 26th September

Around Kirkby Stephen

C Walk Moderately Strenuous 12 miles. Alight Kirkby Stephen, Return Garsdale.

Mallerstang Edge: Hollow Mill Cross (500m), High Pike Hill (642m), High Seat (709m), Gregory Chapel (695m), Hellgill Bridge, The High Way, Yore House, Moorcock Inn. Coach to Hollow Mill Cross.

D Walk Moderate 8 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen.

Climb a Peak Slowly: Nine Standards Rigg. Hollow Mill Cross (500m), Nine Standards Rigg (662m), then it's downhill all the way to Kirkby Stephen.

Coach to Hollow Mill Cross, from Kirkby Stephen.

E Walk Easy 7 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen.

Hollow Mill Cross (500m), Jingling Cove (480m), continuing downhill through Dukerdale, Ewbank Scar into Kirkby Stephen. Coach to Hollow Mill Cross, from Kirkby Stephen.

F Walk Easy 8 miles. Alight and Return Kirkby Stephen.

History in the Landscape: Some castles and fortified houses of the Upper Eden Valley.

Pendragon, Lammerside, Wharton, Hartley, Croglam. Coach from Kirkby Stephen.
